He counsels individuals, companies and national and foreign financial institutions on public and private operations of issuance or sale of debt instruments, shares, participations in mutual and investment funds and water instruments, asset securitization processes.

He also counsels on the constitution of guarantees, trusts, financial leasing, reorganization of companies and acquisition of companies, contracting of derivative instruments, formation of investment funds, as well as in matters related to the regulation of the public offer of acquisition (OPA), public offer of purchase (OPC), public offer of redemption and exchange of investment shares, improper use of privileged information and other capital markets.

He has been an officer in the Superintendence of the Securities Market (SMV) for more than 10 years, where he held various positions of importance.

He participated in the commission that proposed the current Stock Market Law. He led the preparation of asset securitization regulations, public offerings of securities and other relevant regulations, which are currently in force, and proposed the reform of the trust's legislation, from which this figure was developed in the country.
