HEADWORKS AND CONVEYANCE WORKS FOR THE DRINKING WATER SUPPLY FOR LIMA

INVESTMENT AMOUNT: US\$ 517.08 million (CAPEX) / US\$ 262.44 million (OPEX)

The project involves the design, financing, construction, operation, and maintenance of infrastructure aimed at expanding and improving the drinking water service in Lima. It is divided into two phases:

Phase 1 includes the design, financing, construction, operation, and maintenance of: (i) Huachipa II Plant to produce 5 m³/s (in two stages of 2.5 m³/s), including a main reservoir with a total volume of 160,000 m³; (ii) the 25 km South Branch conveyance line, which includes two tunnels totaling 7 km; (iii) five compensation reservoirs with a total volume of 69,000 m³; and (iv) interconnection pipelines with an approximate length of 65 km. It also includes the operation and maintenance of: (i) Huachipa Intake to capture a flow of 12 m³/s from the Rímac River; and (ii) Huachipa I Plant to produce a maximum flow of 5 m³/s of drinking water.

Phase 2 includes: (i) the improvement of the Pomacocha and Huallacocha Bajo dams to store 38 million cubic meters (MMC); and (ii) the construction of a 10 km Trans-Andean Tunnel from Pomacocha to the Blanco River.

EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENT OF WASTEWATER COLLECTION, TREATMENT, AND DISPOSAL SERVICES IN THE TOWNS OF HUANCAYO, EL TAMBO, CHILCA, HUAYUCACHI, HUANCÁN, HUACRAPUQUIO, AND VIQUES, PROVINCE OF HUANCAYO, JUNÍN REGION

NATURAL GAS DISTRIBUTION BY DUCT NETWORK IN THE AREQUIPA, MOQUEGUA AND TACNA REGIONS
